  - C&O Canal
  - symbol for the state capital
  - William Preston Lane Jr. Memorial Bridge
  - Deep Creek Lake
  - county in which you live and the county seat

  - border
  - key/legend
  - title
  - orientation
  - date
  - author
  - scale - 3.5 inches = 50 miles

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
